

## JUVENILE LAW

Our state has three Separate Juvenile Courts, and a Juvenile Code to handle the unique issues involving children under the age of 18 years, and their families.

When children are charged with criminal activity or truancy, or when their behavior is uncontrollable by their families, they need experienced legal representation in Juvenile Court.

Likewise, when parents are facing abuse or neglect allegations, in Juvenile Court, they need knowledgeable counsel to advocate for them, or to assist them in fulfilling the Juvenile Court goal of rehabilitation and reunification of the family.

Sometimes, families require help in obtaining proper mental health care for their children. Our lawyers are experienced in representing children facing charges in Juvenile Court, acting as Guardians ad Litem for children, and representing parents when they require an attorney to work through the Juvenile Court process, no matter what is involved.
